



Dear Driver,

We are taking up the challenge to race at Circuit Park ZANDVOORT / Holland in 2010!

As a lot of drivers are already aware, the organisation of the INTERNATIONAL SUPERKART SERIES is busy carrying out noise tests at Circuit Park Zandvoort, in order to make it possible to organise a Superkart race at the famous circuit in 2010.

On Monday, after the Superkart European Championship round at Assen / Holland, noisy tests have been carried out with the help of the REDSPEED TEAM (John Riley, Robert Chilcott, Dave Harvey), BARKER RACING (Graham Barker, Lee Harpham, Gary Parks) and MS KART HOLLAND (Jan Cramer, Priscilla Speelman, Mark Nachtegeller). Russell Anderson was also present as an advisor.

The results were encouraging and according to Russell Anderson and Jasper Blom (ISS), it will be possible to meet the required maximum level of 92dB without loss of power. To meet this maximum level a simple muffler as well as an effective inlet silencer are sufficient.

The tests are carried out at a fast part of the circuit with the microphone at 24 meters of the racing line and at a height of 5 meters. The noise level should then be 92dB maximum.

On 21 October next, from 09.00-11.00 hours, the ISS is allowed to test again at Zandvoort, together with teams that are interested to race there in 2010.
